Registration Application and Instructions

A completed registration application form [**yellow form**], signed by the Player/Child's Parent and/or Guardian along with a cheque in the amount of \$200 per player must be returned to the North Toronto Basketball office as follows:

Helpful Registration Information:

Dates: Our house league program runs every Saturday beginning on Saturday, October 4th, 2008 and ends in early February except for the Christmas holidays, Saturday, December 20th and 27th, 2008 and January 3rd, 2009; any specific notifications of cancellations.

Available space: Space in all age categories is limited. Preference is given to those players and their siblings who have played in North Toronto Basketball during the 2007-2008 season.

Refunds: There are no refunds after Saturday, October 18th, 2008. A \$50 administration fee is charged on all refunds.

Confirmations: We will be sending out a confirmation indicating your child's admission into this year's program before the season begins.

Deadline: Please ensure that a completed application is submitted to the NTBA prior to JUNE 15th, 2008.

***Conflicts:** We ask that all parents/guardians ensure that their child's participation in NTBA basketball activities is free of all other scheduling conflicts such as hockey or skiing in order to ensure that our program is not subject to disruptions resulting from player absenteeism.

Absenteeism: Any player who is absent for more than four (4) games in a single season, including playoff games, or is regularly or unduly absent for any reason, or who does not notify the Registrar of his/her withdrawal before the first house league game (or week 3), may not be eligible to participate in the following years program.

Schedule and Gyms: Kindly refer to the "*green form*" enclosed.

Financial restrictions: It is the policy of NTBA not to deny access to our program for financial reasons. If the fee would prevent your child from playing in our program, please contact us at (416) 481-1555.

We need your help i.e. Volunteer Coaches: The success of a "quality" community basketball program is a function of the quantity of volunteers within the organization, especially coaches. We need volunteers to become coaches and assistant coaches for house league teams. The Child of a coach or assistant coach would always be placed on the same team as the coach. Enthusiasm, a desire to work with kids and a willingness to learn about basketball are more important than being a former basketball star. We will offer assistance for those that are concerned about their coaching abilities. Kindly complete the registration form (see "yellow form") accordingly.
